

Overview



These plans will result in a two-shelf library with optional side shelf for decoration. Drawings are not to scale; dimensions are approximate. Consider width of saw blade in cuts and level of precision desired. Customize library easily by modifying these concept illustrations.



Ingredients

- ✦ Two sheets of $\frac{3}{4}$ " thick nominal 4' x 8' CDX (exterior grade) plywood.
- ✦ Four three-inch flat L-brackets. 
- ✦ A sheet of $\frac{1}{16}$ " thick plexiglass, at least 15" x 15". 
- ✦ 12 $\frac{1}{16}$ " or $\frac{1}{8}$ " window screen clips. 
- ✦ Two flush type hinges (hinges that lie flat). 
- ✦ A door handle.
- ✦ A box of 2.5" exterior grade screws.

Committee members discussed and thought it was a good idea and directed the Clerk to correspond with Ms. Smith and request plans for the "Little Library" she wanted to erect.

Committee Comments

Scott Cuthbertson suggested that the committee think about adding individual picnic tables with shelters in the wooded areas. He also said he had received several comments from people stating that the play equipment was very hot during mid-day. Scott’s wife suggested that the town may want to start a “Food Truck” day at the park once a month as a way to get the community together and utilize the park.
