**Items of Business**

A. Discuss Lighting for Park

Jerry Clontz reported that he spoke with a representative from Duke Energy regarding the types of lights available for the park as well as the pricing. Mr. Haigler suggested the possibility of using decorative poles instead of the wood poles that were figured in the pricing from Duke Energy. The Committee reviewed the information provided by Duke Energy and discussed various design options.

Leon Whitley made a motion to bring before Council the request to purchase lighting for the park and also to authorize Jerry Clontz to make any decisions necessary regarding the pricing for decorative poles when the pricing information is ready. Rachel Outen seconded the motion. Committee members Clontz, Haigler, Outen and Whitley voted yes (4-0).

B. Review Applications for Committee Vacancy

The Committee reviewed applications from Tom Eure and Michael Morgan for the vacancy on the Committee. The Committee suggested recommending Tom Eure to the Council.

C. Minutes

B.B. Haigler made a motion to approve the May 11, 2017 regular meeting minutes. Leon Whitley seconded the motion. Committee members Clontz, Haigler, Outen and Whitley voted yes (4-0).

## Committee Comments

Jerry Clontz stated that he had received quotes to remove the wood from the burn piles at the back of the park from Mark Cash (\$400) and Jordan Edwards (\$275). Mr. Clontz instructed Mr. Edwards to complete the job as soon as possible.

Leon Whitley suggested that the Committee think about having a farmers market at the park once a week during the summer months.

Jerry Clontz suggested speaking with the Union County Extension Agent to see about programs that could be done at the park or the meeting room, i.e. landscaping, gardening, canning, cooking etc.

B.B. Haigler made a motion to adjourn. Leon Whitley seconded the motion. Committee members Clontz, Haigler, Outen and Whitley voted yes (4-0).
