**Items of Business**

**A. Presentation by Jeff Ashbaugh, Alfred Benesch & Co.**

Mr. Ashbaugh presented the park plan and noted that the bathroom and picnic areas have been reversed as necessitated by where the soil perked. Mr. Ashbaugh handed out information on picnic tables, trash receptacles, benches, bathroom and playground equipment that will be used in the bidding process.

Jerry Clontz discussed adding a small bridge across the spillway and Mr. Ashbaugh noted that the plan called for a culvert which would be easier to maintain.

The committee discussed and decided to upsize the picnic shelter from roughly 24 x 24 to 30 x 42.

Mr. Ashbaugh answered questions from the committee.

B.B. Haigler made a motion to proceed with the plan as changed. Stan Smith seconded the motion. Members Clontz, Haigler, Stan Smith and Sharon Smith voted yes (4-0).

**Committee Comments**

Jerry Clontz gave the committee an update regarding the pond. Mr. Clontz, Leon Whitley and Phil Thomas met with a representative from Foster Lake & Pond Mgt. Inc. at the pond and marked trees to be removed. Foster Lake will be moving their equipment in on Tuesday, June 9<sup>th</sup> and should have the pond cleaned out by the end of the week.

Jerry Clontz also noted that the park property needed to be sprayed for weeds again this year. Mr. Clontz will ask the Council at their next meeting for permission to get an estimate and proceed to get the property sprayed.

B.B. Haigler made the motion to adjourn. Stan Smith seconded the motion. Members Clontz, Haigler, Stan Smith and Sharon Smith voted yes (4-0).
