### Item 1: Discuss request for funds from Turning Point, Inc. in the amount of \$500

Mayor Thomas presented the Turning Point funds request in the amount of \$500. The Council discussed.

Patricia Kindley made a motion to approve \$500 for Turning Point. Jerry Clontz seconded the motion. Council members Biggers, Clontz, Kindley and Wilfong voted yes (4-0).

### Item 2: Discuss/Approve Septic System Easement Agreement

Mayor Thomas presented the agreement for the septic system easement between the town and the fire department. The agreement was composed by the town attorney, Melanie Cox, with input from the Fire Department Board and their attorney. The Council discussed.

Gary Wilfong made a motion to approve the septic system easement agreement between the town and the fire department and give authority to Mayor Thomas to sign the agreement. John Biggers seconded the motion. Council members Biggers, Clontz, Kindley and Wilfong voted yes (4-0).

### Item 3: Discuss Park Access Road from Park to Creek

Jerry Clontz stated that he would like to get estimates for building a trail from the park back to the creek. He suggested that the trail be 16 to 20 feet wide. The Council discussed.

Jerry Clontz made a motion for the Town to get proposals in writing on building a trail from the Park to the creek through the woods where it has been marked. John Biggers seconded the motion. Council members Biggers, Clontz, Kindley and Wilfong voted yes (4-0).

Jerry Clontz asked about progress on hiring a backup for him regarding park maintenance duties. Town Clerk informed him that Tania Hernandez-Virgili had completed the paperwork needed and was ready to work.
